

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
Contra Costa County Program Review

FINDINGS

Finding #1: Contra Costa County did not summarize and analyze the recommended revisions received during the 30-day comment period in the adopted Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-26 Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan).
(Welfare and Institution Code (W&I Code) section 5848(b);
(California Code of Regulations (Cal. Code Regs), title 9, section 3315(a)(3)).

Recommendation #1: The County must provide evidence of compliance for a summary and analysis of the recommended revisions received during the 30-day public comment period, for FY 2024-25. If no recommendations are received, identify no recommendations provided.

Finding #2: Contra Costa County did not include a narrative analysis of the mental health needs of unserved, underserved, inappropriately served, and fully served County residents who qualify for MHSA services in the adopted FY 2023-26 Plan.
(Cal. Code Regs., title 9, section, tit. 9, § 3650(a)(1)).

Recommendation #2: The County must provide evidence of compliance with a current narrative analysis of the mental health needs of unserved, underserved/ inappropriately served, and fully served County residents who qualify for MHSA services.
