## PROPOSED STATE PLAN AMENDMENT FOR MEDICARE PART A BUY-IN

This notice is to provide information of public interest about a proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Proposed SPA #24-0011, pursuant with Senate Bill 311 (Eggman, 2023), requires California to enter into a Medicare Part A Buy-In agreement with the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). California will automatically pay Medicare Part A premiums, deductibles, and coinsurance for Medi-Cal members who are enrolled in both the Medicare program and Medi-Cal program (dually eligible) and qualify for the Qualified Medicare Beneficiary Medicare Savings Program. Dually eligible Medi-Cal members would not be required to complete a multi-step application process with both Social Security Administration (SSA) and the county Medi-Cal eligibility office for Medicare Part A Buy-In.

DHCS estimates cost savings for both state and federal funds.

The effective date of the proposed SPA is October 1, 2024, with implementation expected on January 1, 2025. All proposed SPAs are subject to approval by CMS.
