WITHDRAWAL OF STATE PLAN AMENDMENTS 24-0020, 24-0021, 24-0022, 24-0023, and 24-0024: TARGETED CASE MANAGEMENT SERVICES – CHILDREN UNDER 21, MEDICALLY FRAGILE INDIVIDUALS, INDIVIDUALS AT RISK OF INSTITUTIONALIZATION, INDIVIDUALS IN JEOPARDY OF NEGATIVE PSYCHO-SOCIAL OUTCOMES, AND INDIVIDUALS WITH A COMMUNICABLE DISEASE

Dear Mr. Scott:

The California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is withdrawing State Plan Amendments (SPAs) 24-0020, 24-0021, 24-0022, 24-0023, and 24-0024. These SPAs proposed to update the geographic area offering Targeted Case Management (TCM) services for the following Target Groups: Children Under 21, Medically Fragile Individuals, Individuals at Risk of Institutionalization, Individuals in Jeopardy of Negative Psycho-Social Outcomes, and Individuals with a Communicable Disease.

These SPAs acknowledged Contra Costa, Mendocino, San Luis Obispo, Solano, and Ventura counties' election to not participate in TCM for Target Group - Children Under 21; Contra Costa, Mendocino, Orange, Placer, San Luis Obispo, Shasta, Solano, and Ventura counties' election to not participate in TCM for Target Group - Medically Fragile Individuals; Contra Costa, Mendocino, Orange, Placer, Riverside, San Diego, and Ventura counties' election to not participate in TCM for Target Group - Individuals at Risk of Institutionalization; Contra Costa, Mendocino, Merced, Placer, San Luis Obispo, Shasta, Solano, and Ventura counties' election to not participate in TCM for Target Group - Individuals in Jeopardy of Negative Psycho-Social Outcomes; and Alameda, Contra Costa, Mendocino, Riverside, Solano, Sutter, and Ventura counties' election to not participate in TCM for Target Group – Individuals with a Communicable Disease. However, with the withdrawal of the above referenced SPAs, these counties will continue to participate in TCM for these populations in order to continue complying with the American Rescue Plan Act (Pub. L. 117-2) Section 9817 Additional Support for Medicaid Home and Community-Based Services.
