This action by the Department of Health Care Services (Department) makes changes without regulatory effect to section 51305, in Title 22 of the California Code of Regulations. Specifically, this action removes the utilization cap of eight (8) psychiatry services without prior authorization. This change is required to make section 51305 conform to new Welfare and Institutions Code, section 14132.03, enacted by Statutes 2013, Chapter 4 (SB X1-1). Welfare and Institutions Code, section 14132.03, is also added as a reference citation.

OAL approves this change without regulatory effect as meeting the requirements of California Code of Regulations, Title 1, section 100.

(1) Amend Section 51305 as follows:

Section 51305. Physician Services.

Subsections (a) through (c) - No Changes

(d) A maximum of ~~eight psychiatry services and eight injections~~ for allergy desensitization, hyposensitization, or immunotherapy by injection of an antigen to stimulate production of protective antibodies may be provided in any 120-day period without prior authorization. Prior authorization shall be required when more than ~~eight psychiatry or eight~~ of the above allergy injections are provided in a 120-day period except those provided on an emergency basis.

Subsection (d)(1) - No Changes

(d)(2) A total treatment plan shall be developed for ~~psychiatry and allergy~~ services which require prior authorization. The treatment plan may be authorized for a period up to 120 days and shall include the following:

Subsections (d)(2)(A) through (F) - No Changes

Subsections (e) through (m) - No Changes
