## **History and Purpose**

- Stakeholder Advisory Committee (SAC) created in 2010 for 1115 waiver
- Director Kent created BH-SAC in response to growing importance of BH
- DHCS combined DUI Advisory Group, NTP Advisory Group, YAG and Performance Outcomes Systems Advisory Committee; other specific operational workgroups will continue
- Focused on system-wide, policy level



# **Objectives**

- Offer input, knowledge and experience on how to improve BH components
- Provide feedback on specific strategies proposed by DHCS
- Suggest ideas for approaches to monitor utilization and performance
- Review performance standards and indicators
- Provide comment on waivers (1115/1915b)



# **Guiding Principles**

- Membership reflects diversity of BH stakeholders
- Meetings will be a collegial and open environment
- Meetings will encourage direct communication and problem solving with DHCS
- Meet objectives of BH-SAC
- Regular, consistent attendance and active participation of members



## Membership

- Appointed by DHCS Director
- Recognized and diverse stakeholders
- Attend all regularly scheduled meetings in person (preferred) or by telephone
- Meet 4 times each year
- No substitutes or delegates or proxies
- Agendas developed by DHCS with input on topics from members
- Follow Bagley-Keene Open Meeting Act



#### **Process**

- Calendar of meetings set in October
- Meetings will alternate am/pm with SAC
- Feel free to attend SAC meetings
- Agenda topics circulated 6 weeks advance
- Agenda out week in advance; materials several days before meeting
- Public comment at each meeting



#### **More Process**

- Summaries of each meeting; SAC summaries circulated FYI only
- WiFi available; no copies of materials
- Prefer attendance in person; interactive telephone for members only
- Public listen only telephone line
