

Evidence	

Villas at Topanga Terrace is located with a skilled nursing facility (SNF). They share operations with the SNF and many activities at Villa Topanga Terrace occur in one of the three buildings. Villas at Topanga Terrace did not plan community activities as part of its plan for service and individuals were not supported to participate in community activities. There were practices in place that impeded individuals' access to the broader community and contributed to the institutional nature of Villas at Topanga Terrace. Individuals did not have keys and had to wait for assistance to enter their home after 8:00 pm when the side gate and doors were locked, and individuals were encouraged to be home by 8:00 pm. They use video monitoring.



Summary of Remediation Strategy

In the Remediation Work Plan (RWP) Villas at Topanga Terrace said they plan community activities each month based on the preferences and needs of the individuals. The activities are put on a calendar that is provided to individuals and staff tell individuals about the planned activities in person. Staff assist individuals with transportation and during community activities. During these community activities, individuals have the opportunity to participate in community activities with the people they live with. Villas at Topanga Terrance said assessments are completed at admission and at least quarterly after that to learn about individuals' preferences and support needs. During assessments, the staff note things that make it difficult to access the community in a safe and healthy way. Staff use what they know about individuals' preferences and needs from their Individual Service Plans (ISPs to suggest and plan activities. The person-centered team discusses the benefits of being in the community and the risks the individual has when in the community. Any limitation or restriction is based on an assessed need, documented in the ISP, and reviewed at least annually.

The Villas at Topanga Terrace have addressed the practices that impede community access by disabling the side gate lock so that individuals can come and go through the gate as they choose. They eliminated the curfew, and the door is not locked until 10:00 pm. Beginning in May 2022, individuals are offered a key to the front door. If there is an identified need that has been identified that resulted in a restriction, the restriction is documented in the ISP, and reviewed at least annually. The admission agreement has been modified. The admission agreement says there is not a curfew, the gate is no longer locked, and individuals are given a key unless there is restriction based on an assessed need documented in the ISP. The administrator will develop a policy for the use of video cameras and place a sign on the doors. The policy will state that only the administrator has access to the videos, recordings will only be reviewed if there is an incident, and the recording will auto-delete after thirty days.

Although Villas at Topanga Terrace is on the same property as a SNF and shares operations with the SNF. individuals will be supported to engage in the community and institutional practices will be minimized. Restrictions are only used when there is an assessed need, the restriction is documented in the ISP, and the person-centered team reviews restrictions at least annually.
