

# AB 102 HEALTH ENROLLMENT NAVIGATORS PROJECT FOR CLINICS

Data Report Summary



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## INFORMATIONAL NARRATIVE

Assembly Bill (AB) 102 appropriated a total of \$20M Total Funds (\$10M General Fund) to the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) to provide funding for Community Health Centers (CHCs) and Regional Clinic Associations (RCAs) to serve hard-to-reach potentially eligible Medi-Cal populations from July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2025. DHCS awarded California Primary Care Association (CPCA) the \$20M to serve as the third-party administrator and project work efforts started January 1, 2024. The Medi-Cal Health Enrollment Navigators Project for Clinics includes 98 CHCs and 9 RCAs across 38 counties.

Enrollment and retention data is reviewed to eliminate duplicates, identify enrollment and retention statuses, and reduce incomplete data. Enrollment and retention data are reported at an individual level allowing for various stratifications including sex, age, written language, spoken language, and race/ethnicity.

### Activities and Definitions

- **Enrollment:** This field indicates the number of individuals encountered and enrolled into/approved for Medi-Cal as a result of submitting their application package.
- **Retention:** This field indicates the number of individuals encountered and approved for re-enrollment by the renewal date or within the 90-day cure period, or able to continue their enrollment in Medi-Cal by proactively submitting the required documents, as part of the annual redetermination process.

The following data points are reported by the project partners as aggregate totals.

- **Direct Outreach:** This field indicates the number of individuals directly encountered as part of the outreach activities. Outreach is defined as individuals being informed or educated about the Medi-Cal program including how to apply for and keep Medi-Cal benefits, if eligible. Example activities include community events, handing out flyers, direct calls, direct emails, and direct messages.
- **Media Outreach:** This field indicates the number of impressions encountered through various media platforms as part of the outreach activities. Example activities include radio ads, billboard ads, and Instagram posts.

- **Application Assistance:** This field indicates the number of individuals receiving assistance on how to apply for Med-Cal, fill out an application, and/or submit required substantiating documentation.
- **Assistance with Accessing and Utilizing Health Care Services:** This field indicates the number of individuals encountered and assisted with resolving any problems or requesting assistance in order to utilize their existing Medi-Cal benefits. Examples include providing assistance with utilizing services such as dental or medical office visits.
- **Assistance with Troubleshooting:** This field indicates the number of individuals encountered and assisted with resolving any problem or issues associated with being enrolled into or keeping their existing Medi-Cal benefits. Examples include assisting individuals with eligibility problems or case management issues in order to keep their on-going Medi-Cal benefits.
- **Assistance with Redeterminations:** This field indicates the number of individuals encountered and assisted with resolving any problems or issues associated with keeping their existing Medi-Cal benefits. Examples include assisting individuals with renewal application, obtaining the required documents for renewal, and reminding beneficiaries of an upcoming renewal.

## DATA DISCLAIMERS AND CONTEXTUAL INFORMATION

The following information is needed to contextualize the data as it reads in this project summary report:

- Data report summarizes efforts from January 1, 2024, through May 31, 2024.
- Demographic information reported (i.e. sex, age, etc.) was self-reported by each individual who was enrolled or retained.
- Enrollment and retention submissions have been scrubbed for duplication, however, individuals can be encountered and assisted with multiple times throughout the course of the project.
- " \* " indicates cell suppression for cell values less than 11; " \*\*" indicates complimentary suppression.
- The totals for each table may vary due to not all data fields and/or demographic information being reported.
