SUBJECT: MEDI-CAL WHAT IT MEANS TO YOU (PUB 68 ENGLISH/SPANISH)

Purpose:

Advise counties of updates to PUB 68.

- PUB 68 (July 2007), MEDI-CAL WHAT IT MEANS TO YOU (ENGLISH/SPANISH), replaces PUB 68 (NOV 2005).
- PUB 68 (July 2007) will be available from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) Warehouse beginning in mid November 2007.

Details:

The changes to PUB 68 improve flow, improve clarity or accommodate new information within the existing format.

Summary of the changes to PUB 68:

Cover: The Medi-Cal logo replaces the previous graphic. Table of Contents: Eliminates Section 16 (PUB 68 NOV 2005 version) and renumbers other sections.

Department Name: The new department name, Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), is incorporated throughout the publication.

County/State Contacts: Contact information for county welfare departments and state offices is updated.

Allowable Assets/Property: Allowable amount an at home spouse can keep when the other one spouse is in a medical institution or nursing facility in Section 5 is updated to \$101,640.

Edits:

Dental Care: Beginning on the first page of Section 2 references to the availability of dental care coverage are inserted throughout PUB 68.

Noncitizen Victims of Human Trafficking and Other Serious Crimes (TCVAP): A new paragraph about TCVAP is added to Section 2.

Medi-Cal Savings Programs: Section 2, Paragraph F is revised.

Former Foster Child Program: Section 2 D makes clear that former foster children are eligible if they are in foster care on their 18th birthday.

Breast and Cervical Cancer Treatment Program (BCCTP): Section 2, Paragraph H. is clarified.

Residency: Section 6, first paragraph clarifies exemption for adoption and foster care beneficiaries.

Verification/Proof: Section 9, B Items 3 and 4 are replaced for consistency with current citizenship policy.

Benefit Identification Cards: Sections 14 and 16 are revised. Old Section 16 (PUB 68 Nov 2005) is deleted. Information about the paper card is incorporated into Section 14.

Managed Care: Sections 25 and 26 are renumbered (old numbers 26 and 27) and revised for clarity.

Buy In: Section 31, paragraph 9, Medicare Premium Payment Program (Buy In) is revised.

Required Action:

Counties must discontinue use of PUB 68 (Nov 2005) no later than February 1, 2008.
