

SUBJECT: Suspending Denials of Applications Submitted Through the California

Healthcare Eligibility, Enrollment and Retention System (CalHEERS)

This letter provides interim guidance to counties that they should not deny Medi-Cal applications submitted via CalHEERS until further notice from the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), except for individuals who are already in an active Medi-Cal case in the Statewide Automated Welfare System (SAWS) (consistent with previous Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter I-14-02).

When the interface between SAWS and CalHEERS is launched and all appropriate notices for denials are ready to be sent, counties will be notified by DHCS. At that point, upon notification by DHCS, counties should resume denial processes in accordance with current policy.
