

SUBJECT: Self-Certification of County Performance Standards Not Required For 2014

The purpose of this Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Informational Letter (MEDIL) is to clarify that the counties are not required to report the self-certification of performance standards for the calendar year 2014. Historically, the 25 counties with the largest Medi-Cal populations, as identified in All County Welfare Directors Letter 09-07 sampled and reported on county performance standards every other year. For example, these counties reported their 2013 performance standards in early 2014 and would report 2015 performance standards in 2016. The guidelines for the Self-Certifications are available in the Medi-Cal Procedures Manual, Article 25, A-1. However, the Department of Health Care Services wishes to make it clear that there is no requirement for the counties to submit to DHCS, self-certification performance standards for 2014.
