- SUBJECT: GUIDANCE FOR CARR V BECERRA RESTORATION LIST EFFORT (Ref. MEDIL I 23-07, MEDIL I 23-18)

The purpose of this letter is to provide counties with instruction on maintaining eligibility for individuals impacted by *Carr v. Becerra, No. 22-cv-0098 (D. Conn.).* 

## Background

As outlined in <u>Medi-Cal Division Information Letter (MEDIL) I 23-18</u>, DHCS has restored eligibility for individuals who moved from a Qualified Medicare Beneficiary program (QMB) to Specified Low-Income Medicare Beneficiary program (SLMB) or Qualifying Individual (QI) from March 1, 2020, through March 31, 2023. DHCS reinstated beneficiaries to their original MSP program directly in the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS). Beneficiaries will remain in the same tier of MSP coverage until their continuous coverage unwinding renewal is completed.

DHCS has established a process to ensure these individuals maintain their coverage until their unwinding renewal is complete.

## New List Effort During the Unwinding Period

During the Continuous Coverage Unwinding period, beneficiaries are given an opportunity to complete a full redetermination prior to being discontinued from Medi-Cal eligibility. Cases up for renewal shall be appropriately redetermined in accordance with the guidance issued in <u>ACWDL 22-18</u>. To prevent erroneous discontinuances of coverage during the unwinding period activities, SAWS, DHCS, and counties will utilize a list provided by DHCS to identify cases that DHCS has restored, and counties need to maintain during the Unwinding period.
