SUBJECT: EXTENDED PERIOD OF ELIGIBILITY FOR UKRAINIAN

HUMANITARIAN PAROLEES (Reference: Medi-Cal Eligibility Division

Information Letter No.: <u>I 22-16</u>, <u>I 22-30</u>, and <u>I 24-08</u>)

The purpose of this Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter (MEDIL) is to provide updated information regarding the Medi-Cal eligibility requirements for displaced Ukrainian populations arriving in the United States.

## **Background**

To address the needs of Ukrainian parolees impacted by the war in Ukraine, the federal government extended full scope Medi-Cal and Refugee Medical Assistance (RMA) to eligible persons who met certain other requirements. Previously, eligibility was limited to individuals who were paroled between February 24, 2022, and September 30, 2023, under the Additional Ukraine Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2022 (AUSAA).

## **Extended Period of Eligibility for Ukrainian Humanitarian Parolees**

On April 24, 2024, President Biden signed into law the <u>Ukraine Security Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2024 (USSAA)</u>, authorizing Office of Refugee Resettlement to provide resettlement assistance and other benefits to specific Ukrainian populations (including non-Ukrainian individuals who last habitually resided in Ukraine) who are paroled into the U.S. between February 24, 2022 and September 30, 2024 under Section 207 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) (8 U.S.C. § 1157).

## **Review for Other Eligibility**

As a reminder, if a member loses the eligibility established per MEDIL <u>I 22-16</u>, or <u>I 23-30</u>, or <u>I 24-08</u>, counties are to determine eligibility for any other programs (in accordance with current Medi-Cal policy) before terminating those benefits with proper notice.
