INCREASE IN THE SUBSTANTIAL GAINFUL ACTIVITY (SGA) AMOUNT

Ref.: E-Mail C2 DHS No. 2001-55

This letter is to inform counties that effective January 1, 2002, the new SGA amount for non-blind individuals will be increased to \$780. All SGA determinations made on/or after January 1, 2002, should utilize the new amount. This information was distributed to counties via E-Mail in December 2001. The Social Security Administration published final regulations in the Federal Register that require annual adjustments to the SGA amount based on the average wage index.

Since the SGA amount is likely to change annually, future reference to the actual SGA amount in the Medi-Cal Eligibility Procedure's Manual (MEPM) will only be indicated on pages 22C-2.1 and 22C-2.2. All other reference to the SGA amount in the MEPM will only state "Current SGA Amount" and no dollar figure will be noted. County staff preparing SGA determinations will insert the current SGA amount on the MC 272 (SGA worksheet) and MC 273 (SGA work activity form). Both forms were recently revised reflecting this change and are available in the warehouse.

Counties are instructed to retroactively redetermine Medi-Cal eligibility based on disability if a case has been denied erroneously due to a delay in implementing the new SGA amount.
