SUBJECT: REFUGEE/ALIEN INDICATOR CODE - CITIZEN CODE

The purpose of this letter is to request that county welfare departments change the non-citizen refugee indicator code whenever a refugee client becomes a United States citizen.

Upon proper verification of U.S. citizenship status, please change the refugee indicator code to A – proven U.S. citizen. This will ensure a more accurate count of refugees on aid who are eligible for refugee-funded services. However, changing the indicator code will not remove the refugee from the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System refugee database, which contains the overall statewide number of refugees who have received aid since 1980.
