SUBJECT: THE EXTENSION OF THE QUALIFYING INDIVIDUAL 1 PROGRAM
SUNSET DATE TO SEPTEMBER 30, 2007
(Reference All County Welfare Directors Letter Nos.: 98-08, 98-15, 98-47,
98-60, 99-14, 99-43, 99-61, 03-02, 03-20, 03-51, 04-11, and 04-38)

This letter notifies counties that on October 19, 2005, H.R. 3971 was signed into law, which extends the Qualifying Individuals-1 (QI-1) sunset date to September 30, 2007.

The QI-1 program provides the State payment of the Medicare Part B premium for individuals with income below 135 percent of the federal poverty level. The QI-1 program was originally scheduled to sunset December 31, 2002, but Congress has granted a number of temporary extensions.

Because the QI-1 program has been extended many times, counties are to continue accepting applications and determining eligibility for the QI-1 program until the California Department of Health Services (CDHS) notifies them that the QI-1 program has been discontinued. If the QI-1 program is discontinued, CDHS will: notify the county of the termination date; discontinue the QI-1 eligibility reporting on the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System; discontinue the Medicare Part B buy-in; send a notice of discontinuance to the QI-1; and send a listing of discontinued QI-1s so that the county systems can be updated.
