SUBJECT: INCOME AND PROPERTY EXEMPTION FOR ADVANCE PAYMENTS
UNDER THE IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE SERVICES INDEPENDENCE
PLUS 1115 DEMONSTRATION PROJECT AND IN-HOME SUPPORTIVE
SERVICE RESIDUAL PROGRAM
(Reference: 05-21, 05-26, 05-29, and 06-04)

The purpose of this letter is to remind counties that the advance payments and restaurant meal allowances received by In-Home Supportive Services (IHSS) recipients under the In-Home Supportive Services Independence Plus 1115 Demonstration Project (IHSS Waiver) are considered exempt income and property.

BACKGROUND

The IHSS Plus Waiver was implemented August 1, 2004. It is a federal waiver that provides in-home services to federally funded Medi-Cal recipients. In its approval letter to the California Department of Health Services (CDHS), the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services provided the authority for CDHS to exempt from income and property, advance IHSS payments made under the IHSS Waiver. However, pursuant to the California Code of Regulations, Section 50527, and All County Welfare Directors' Letter 90-01, draft regulations, Section 50455.5, this income and property exemption further extends to include payments received for social services. This exemption

applies to advance payments for IHSS and restaurant meal allowances under the IHSS Waiver.
