SUBJECT: MEDI-CAL MIDYEAR STATUS REPORT (MSR) REQUIREMENTS
ERRATA

This All County Welfare Directors Letter (ACWDL) errata provides counties with an update to ACWDL 09-32, Section V, Page 5, instructions to counties to make reporting schedule modifications. Previously, the Medi-Cal Eligibility Division (MCED) instructed counties/consortia that the MSR Mail Month should occur on the sixth month after the initial eligibility determination or most recent annual redetermination. As a result, the MSR Due Month fell on the seventh month after the initial eligibility determination or most recent annual redetermination. ACWDL 09-32 instructed counties/consortia to change the MSR Mail Month to the fifth month and the MSR Due Month to occur on the sixth month. Counties/consortia were instructed to implement this change on or before June 30, 2010.

Recently, some counties/consortia informed MCED that, due to existing and otherwise unforeseen priorities, there has been a delay in their systems' programming to comply with the June 30, 2010, deadline. As such, MCED extends the deadline for the MSR mail month implementation change to no later than December 31, 2010.
