

SUBJECT: Medi-Cal Budget Calculation Chart/2012 Federal Poverty Levels

(Reference: All County Welfare Directors Letters Numbers: 99-25, 00-05, 00-33, 01-31, 02-27, 03-09, 02-23, 03-43, 04-07, 04-16, 07-17, 08-15, 08-37,

08-61, 09-09, 09-64, 11-18).

This letter informs counties of the updated Medi-Cal Budget Calculation Chart which incorporates income and resource limits for a variety of public assistance programs into one chart. The chart was originally designed by Sutter County. The Department of Health Care Services found the chart useful and wanted to share it with all counties. Please be aware that some of the values reflected in the chart may change at various times during the year.

Please note that while the Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment levels remain at the May 2009 levels, the In-Kind Support and Maintenance, Federal Benefit Rate and Standard Allocation, which are all based on the cost of living standards, have increased to the 2012 level. An erratum will be sent for All County Welfare Director's Letter 11-44 in the near future.
