REGISTER LISTING FOR TITLE II DISREGARD ELIGIBLES

In our "All County Letter" of May 14, 1979 (letter number 79-13) we explained that the State would continue to send no-cost Medi-Cal cards to individuals identified by the Social Security Administration as having been terminated from SSI/SSP in July due exclusively to the OASDI increase. In addition we stated lists of residents in your county who were given automatic Title II Disregard status would be forwarded to you. Those lists have been produced and attached to the liaison copy of this letter is a list of residents of your county who received no cost Medi-Cal cards for August. The Department did not produce a listing of the July Title II Disregard cases because only 250 persons statewide received cards through this process. Apparently not all of the SSI/SSP termination records were available to the Department prior to the July card production process. As a result most of the 7,000 Title II Disregard cases received regular_SSI/SSP cards in July.

Issuance of the no-cost Medi-Cal cards will continue until the new SSI/SSP payment levels are applied by the Social Security Administration. Based on the new payment level, those individuals who remain ineligible for SSI/SSP will be advised, via a special card stuffer, to contact the county welfare department if they wish to apply for Medi-Cal only. Counties will also be given lists of those individuals who were not restored to the SSI/SSP program.
