LYNCH V. RANK

One of the court-ordered requirements in the case of Lynch v. Rank is that county welfare departments (CWDs) conduct annual Pickle eligibility training. This is to be accomplished during the month preceding the Title II cost of living adjustment (COLA) and is to be provided for all staff responsible for determining Pickle eligibility.

Counties must complete this training prior to January 1, 1985 (the effective date of the next Title II COLA) using the materials provided in All County Welfare Directors Letter No. 83-74 and those provided during the original (November 1983) state training or any materials developed by the CWD using the state instructions.
