SUBJECT: PAMPHLET - MEDI-CAL FOR DISABLED PERSONS

A new publication entitled "Medi-Cal For Disabled Persons" has been published and is now available. The purpose of the pamphlet is to explain Medi-Cal disability criteria and procedures to applicants and provide information on how applicants can best assist in the determination process.

Pursuant to the court order in <u>Visser v. Kizer</u>, this pamphlet <u>must</u> be available in the reception areas of <u>all</u> county welfare offices by August 24, 1986. A copy of this pamphlet should also be provided to any person applying for Medi-Cal on the basis of disability and may, if desired, be placed in county hospitals, clinics, or other county medical program offices. The information provided in the pamphlet will hopefully assist applicant's in completing the disability evaluation procedure and will answer some of the more frequent questions raised about disability.
