SUBJECT: OMNIBUS DRUG BILL, NO. 144 - PART II: TREATMENT OF

HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS ELIGIBLE UNDER SSI AND MEDICAID

PROGRAMS

The President recently signed into law the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1986 which included a number of provisions regarding extension of welfare benefits to the homeless. Under these provisions Medicaid coverage to otherwise eligible homeless individuals is mandated. The Secretary of Health and Human Services is directed to devise a method to provide eligibility cards to homeless beneficiaries.

As you know, California presently provides Medi-Cal cards to these individuals. Therefore, we do not expect this new law to have any impact on California. We do, however, want you to be aware of these provisions to ensure that the otherwise eligible homeless individuals continue to receive Medi-Cal cards.
