### NOTICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the requirements of 42 CFR § 447.205, that the Director of the Department of Health Services intends to reduce by ten percent the maximum allowable reimbursement for services to providers under the Medi-Cal Program, across the board, in each of the following categories: physician (except maternity care services), other medical (except rural health clinics), hospital outpatient, drug ingredients and dispensing fee, transportation, other services, home health, Child Health and Disability Prevention, and Adult Day Health Care. This action is proposed to take effect for services rendered on or after February 1, 1987.

The ten percent reduction is being made under the authority of Welfare and Institutions Code Section 14120, because of an anticipated shortfall in the Medi-Cal budget for the fiscal year 1986/87. The estimated decrease in General Fund expenditures expected from this action is \$18.704 million in this fiscal year.

This notice of the proposed changes is available for public review in the County Welfare offices of each county. Written comments by interested persons may be sent to the Rate Development Branch, Department of Health Services, 714 P Street, Room 1550, Sacramento, California 95814, where they may be reviewed by the public.
