SUBJECT: MEDI-CAL CARD REDESIGN

The Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch has determined a need to consider alternatives to the current design and format of the Medi-Cal card to accommodate changing program requirements.

The Branch has formed a Medi-Cal Card Redesign Task Force, currently composed of Department of Health Services representatives who wish to provide input for a report being prepared on suggested changes to the MC 300, MC 301 and MC 302 Medi-Cal cards. After reviewing and studying each of the suggested changes, the report will recommend which changes, if any, should be proposed and implemented.

The Branch would like to extend an invitation to county welfare departments to participate in this project. Task Force meetings are currently being held weekly on Tuesdays from 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon in Sacramento.
