ESTATE RECOVERY STUFFER

It has come to our attention that certain public assistance recipients, particularly SSI/SSP and IHSS recipients may not be aware of the Medi-Cal estate recovery process.

One of the ways to inform them of the process is to include the information in an annual stuffer to all Medi-Cal recipients and a semi-annual mailing to SSI/SSP recipients.

Attached is a copy of the English/Spanish stuffer which we propose to release with the October 1987 Medi-Cal cards. This is basically the same information that was originally sent out in 1982.
