SUBJECT: CARETAKER RELATIVES LINKED TO A CHILD ON PUBLIC
ASSISTANCE (PA) OR OTHER PA

This is to advise you of new instructions which will allow a caretaker relative without a spouse and/or children living in the home to be linked to a child receiving Public Assistance (PA) or Other PA.

Currently, only a parent of a child receiving PA may be linked to AFDC, if that child is also deprived. (See the Medi-Cal Eligibility Manual Procedures Section 5C I B(9)).

To comply with federal requirements, effective from the date of this letter for new cases and at the next redetermination for continuing cases, counties shall advise a caretaker relative with no spouse and/or children living in the home that he/she may request Medi-Cal based on AFDC linkage to a child receiving PA or Other PA (similar to the parent linked to a PA child). The caretaker relative would be in a Medi-Cal Family Budget Unit (MFBU) of one since the child is receiving a cash grant and is not in the MFBU.

Regulations to implement this change are scheduled for public hearing on May 4, 1988.
