SUBJECT: NEW MEDS NETWORK LIAISON ASSIGNMENTS

This is to inform you of the Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch (MEB), Systems Unit, Medi-Cal Eligibility Data Systems (MEDS) Network liaison staff county assignments and to give you a brief reminder of the general duties of the Systems Unit. Enclosed for your information are names and telephone numbers of each staff person and the counties for which each is responsible (Attachment I). Please note the liaison for your county and contact him/her for any MEDS/CDB (foodstamp) problems/questions.

The Systems Unit is generally responsible for the MEDS and other Medi-Cal Eligibility operational functions. The MEB, MEDS liaisons will be responsible, with the exception of those matters that would require you to contact the Data Systems Branch directly, for responding to any MEDS eligibility AFDC-Medi-Cal, Medi-Cal Only and Food Stamp system problems/questions. Please note, to avoid confusion and the duplication of work, the county MEDS/CDB coordinator/liaison or supervisor, should be the person contacting the State MEDS Network liaisons.

The enclosed organizational chart (Attachment II) identifies the functions performed by Systems Unit staff. While this list is not all inclusive it indicates the types of functions performed and should help you in determining which staff to contact.

If you have any questions, please feel free to contact your State MEDS Network liaison or the Systems Unit Support staff.
