SUBJECT: IMPLEMENTATION DATE OF MEDI-CAL TRANSFER OF PROPERTY PROVISIONS UNDER THE MEDICARE CATASTROPHIC ACT OF 1988

Many counties are aware that the Medicare Catastrophic Act of 1988 (MCAA) contains new provisions affecting Medi-Cal eligibility due to the transfer of assets by institutionalized individuals. DO NOT IMPLEMENT THESE PROVISIONS until written instructions are issued by this Department. The Department is in the process of requesting a delay until January 1, 1990 from the Secretary of Health and Human Services to allow the State Legislature sufficient time to enact new legislation, and to allow the Department sufficient time to develop new state regulations and county procedures before implementing the new transfer of property provisions.
