SUBJECT: RETENTION PERIOD FOR LYNCH V. RANK (PICKLE) CASES

The purpose of this letter is to inform counties of the required retention period for Pickle cases. Several counties have contacted the Department of Health Services to inquire about the retention period due to minimal storage space in county welfare offices.

The retention period is three years from: 1) the date the retroactive Pickle claims become inactive; 2) the date the county lost contact with the claimant; or 3) the date the person expired. The active cases, and those potential cases pending in the Pickle Tickler System, should be retained indefinitely.
