SUBJECT: OTHER HEALTH COVERAGE

In November 1988, the Department of Health Services' (DHS), Health Insurance Unit (HIU) mailed a questionnaire to all beneficiaries who were known to have Other Health Coverage (OHC) that was not cost avoided. The questionnaire asked about the scope of insurance coverage. The OHC codes of respondents indicating comprehensive coverage were converted to cost avoidance. Of some 67,000 beneficiaries contacted, approximately 14,000 were converted to cost avoidance.

A second conversion effort will begin late in January 1990, with the mailing of a questionnaire to those beneficiaries identified as having OHC since November 1988. A copy of the questionnaire is included for your information. If the beneficiary's response indicates full coverage, HIU will update MEDS with the appropriate cost avoidance code. Counties will receive a worker alert for any beneficiary whose MEDS record has been changed. A follow-up questionnaire to non-respondents is anticipated in May.
