RECIPIENTS TERMINATED DUE TO FAILURE TO PARTICIPATE IN GAIN

REFERENCE: ACWDL 90-41

Please disregard All County Welfare Directors Letter 90-41 which informed you that an Aid To Families With Dependent Children (AFDC) recipient (parent or caretaker relative) who is terminated due to his/her failure to participate in the Greater Avenues for Independence (GAIN/JOBS) program is also not eligible for Medi-Cal Only as an AFDC-MN parent or caretaker relative.

The ACWDL was premature. Do not discontinue or deny any individual who was terminated from AFDC for failure to cooperate in the GAIN/JOBS program at this time if they are otherwise eligible for Medi-Cal. This message was transmitted to counties via electronic message (MEDS system) on May 15, 1990.
