SUBJECT: Federal Posters Announcing The Zebley Lawsuit Settlement

The recent court order in the case of Zebley v. Sullivan has changed the Social Security Administration (SSA) disability determination criteria for children. As a result, SSA must review all denials of childhood disability made by the Supplemental Security Income/State Supplementary Payment (SSI/SSP) program back to January 1, 1980. SSA is sending a notice to all of the class members informing them of the order and the proper procedures for obtaining a reevaluation for SSI/SSP.

Enclosed you will find copies of the Federal poster announcing the conclusion of the Zebley lawsuit and the procedures for applying for benefits under the Zebley settlement. Please display these posters in prominent locations in the public waiting areas of your local welfare offices.
