SUBJECT: Verification of Identity

The purpose of this letter is to clarify policy concerning when to accept a sworn statement for identity purposes.

Title 22, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Section 50167 (a)(6), allows identity to be verified by viewing one of the following:

- (A) California drivers license;
- (B) Identification card issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles;
- (C) Any other document which appears to be valid and established identity.

Identity can also be verified by viewing one of the following:

- I.D. that has a picture of the person is preferred.
- 2. U.S. Citizenship or Alien Status Documents (passport)
- 3. Birth Certificate
- 4. School Identification Card
- 5. Voters Registration
- 6. Marriage Record
- 7. Divorce Decree
- 8. Work Badge, Building Pass
- 9. Draft Card, Military I.D.
- 10. Adoption Record
- 11. Court Order for Name Change

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- 12. Clinic, Doctor/Hospital Record/Admission Record
- 13. Church Membership or Baptism/Confirmation Record
- 14. Vaccination Record
- 15. Insurance Policy
- 16. Utility Bills
- 17. Two pieces of mail received at their address
- 18. Any other documents providing identifying data such as physical description, photographs

When the applicant's identity cannot be verified by any of the above documents, the eligibility worker must document in the case record that the applicant did make a diligent effort to secure the above documents. Then the applicant should sign and date an affidavit under the penalty of perjury.
