CALIFORNIA CHILDREN'S SERVICES (CCS) ACCESS TO MEDS

State Medi-Cal Eligibility Branch (MEB) has given CCS staff authorization to access Medi-Cal Eligibility Data Systems (MEDS) inquiry status only (see ACWL E-Mail DHS #93077, dated April 30, 1993) in three State Regional Offices, 32 State directed dependent CCS counties and 28 independent CCS counties.

MEB and Data Systems Branch staff have assisted State CCS in establishing a State level CCS/MEDS Coordinator (Liaison). The Liaison will issue MEDS names and passwords and see that all CCS staff understand the confidentiality and security procedures governing disclosure of MEDS and/or Medi-Cal information.

State CCS staff have begun MEDS training and issuing of MEDS passwords to counties CCS staff. All questions concerning CCS access to MEDS should be directed to:
