USE OF MEDI-CAL MAIL-IN APPLICATION FORMS BY COUNTY ELIGIBILITY STAFF

Ref.: All County Welfare Director Letter No. 98-19

The purpose of this letter is to inform counties that the mail-in Medi-Cal application forms developed in conjunction with the Healthy Families Program may be used by county eligibility staff when taking applications for families as well as pregnant women and children.

REMINDER: A face-to-face interview is not required for applications for pregnant women and children only except at the applicant's request or if the county feels it is necessary for good cause, suspicion of fraud, or completion of the application process. A face-to-face interview is still required for applications for everyone in the household.

Counties have the option of using the MC 210 (Statement of Facts) for walk-in applications for families if they prefer.
