HEALTHY FAMILIES (HF) AND MEDI-CAL OUTREACH

The purpose of this letter is to inform county welfare departments of the number of children under the age of 21 as of June 9, 1999, in your county who are receiving Food Stamp benefits but are not receiving medical assistance. A listing of the number of children by county has been printed out from the Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) database and is enclosed with this letter.

The federal Balanced Budget Act of 1997 created the Children Health Insurance Program. In California, this is the Healthy Families Program (HFP), and, as I am sure you are aware, a major outreach effort was begun in the State of California headed by the Department of Health Services (DHS) and the Managed Risk Medical Insurance Board which has involved the cooperation and collaborative efforts of county welfare departments, other state agencies, community-based organizations, the Department of Education, school districts, ethnic organizations, and many private corporations who have devoted a great deal of their services and monetary assistance to ensure that every child in California will be able to receive medical care when needed.

In furtherance of the medical outreach efforts that you may already be involved in, we would request your assistance in extending your outreach efforts to Food Stamp children who have not applied for medical assistance and inform them that health care is available for their children through either the Medi-Cal Program or the HF program.

In order to assist you in this endeavor, we would supply your county with a MEDS printout with the name, address, case number, and eligibility worker in zip code order of all children under the age of 21 who are receiving Food Stamps but are not receiving Medi-Cal or HF. We would suggest that you send them an informational notice such as is enclosed with this letter or inform them that these programs are available at the time of application for Food Stamps.
