SUBJECT: MEDI-CAL MAIL-IN APPLICATION MC 210 (04/06)

Purpose

Advise counties:

- MC 210 (04/06), Medi-Cal Mail-In Application, is now available.
- MC 210 (04/06) is available on the California Department of Health Services (CDHS) website at: <http://www.dhs.ca.gov/mcs/medi-calhome/MC210.htm>

Details

Updates to MC 210 (04/06) include:

- Change revision date to 04/06 (all pages).
- Change 'welfare office' to 'social services office', improving the ability of the applicant to find the county's address in a telephone directory (all pages).
- Inform applicants of the need to obtain services from an enrolled Medi-Cal provider once they submit an application (page 4).
- Informed applicants of the option to make an early Medi-Cal managed care plan selection as required by SB 785, Chapter 389, Statutes of 2004 (page 5).

- Modified the existing bridging question to allow parents to consent to the transfer of their child's case information to the Healthy Families program at any time the child's circumstances change and the child no longer qualifies for no-cost Medi-Cal (page A4, Q54).

Required Action

Counties are to:

- Use existing supplies of MC 210 forms.
- Order bulk supplies of MC 210 (04/06) from the CDHS Warehouse as needed.
- Note that MC 210 (04/06) is available in English and Spanish only. The remaining languages should be revised later this year.

Ordering

To order MC 210 (04/06):

- Counties should use the standard ordering process of submitting an order form (DHS 2031) to the CDHS Warehouse.
