STRATEGIES TO ADDRESS IDENTIFIED HOUSING AND SERVICE GAPS IN THE COUNTY
<p>County Narrative Description (200-word limit)</p> <p>Anthem Blue Cross and CalViva Health partnered with the CoC lead agency – Kings/Tulare Homeless Alliance (KTHA) and Kings County to develop the Housing and Homelessness Incentive Program (HHIP) County Local Homelessness Plan for Kings County. The proposed strategies align with the recommendations from the Kings County 2019 Homelessness Gaps Analysis focused on creating a community engagement, coordination, PSH and RRH, low barrier shelter/navigation center, landlord engagement, homeless outreach, and transportation, and HHAP 3 strategies focused on landlord engagement, linkages to PSH, engagement with tribal communities, homelessness prevention, partnership with medical providers, and increases to outreach.</p> <p>While the MCPs are aligning with broader community strategies, HHIP strategies will specifically focus on data sharing/HMIS access, integration with the Coordinated Entry System (CES), partnerships with street medicine programs, addressing disparities, and ensuring strong implementation of CalAIM ECM and CS housing services. Lastly, based on CoC immediate gaps, there is a desire among partners to support those experiencing unsheltered homelessness by expanding emergency shelter, housing navigation, and outreach services.</p> <p>Anthem and CalViva Health will collaborate with KTHA and Kings County throughout the program period to implement HHIP strategies, meet program measures, and create robust housing and healthcare partnerships to address homelessness in Kings County.</p>
