

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has conducted its Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Fiscal Year 2024-25 program review of Stanislaus County's programs and services. The review found no findings and no suggested improvements. Stanislaus County did not indicate the number of Children, Transitional Age Youth, Adults, and Older Adults to be served, and did not provide the cost per person for Community Services and Supports, Prevention and Early Intervention, and Innovation, in the Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-26 Plan and FY 2024-25 Update. (Welfare and Institution Code section 5847(e); California Code Regulations, §§ 3650 (a)(3), 3755(k)(1), 3755(o)(8), 3930(c)(4)(C)).

Stanislaus County addressed this through the development and implementation of FY 2026-2029 Integrated Plan. No findings will be issued.
