

## Background

### State Specific Reporting Requirements

Dual Eligible Special Needs Plans (D-SNPs) are Medicare Advantage (MA) plans that provide specialized care and wrap-around services for dual eligible beneficiaries (eligible for both Medicare and Medicaid). The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) requires several types of quality reporting for MA plans, which includes D-SNPs. In addition to all federally required MA reporting requirements, the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) has state-specific reporting requirements for D-SNPs, including Medi-Medi Plans, referred to here as Exclusively Aligned Enrollment (EAE) D-SNPs, non-EAE D-SNPs, and SCAN's Fully Integrated Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (FIDE SNP). These requirements are detailed in the Reporting Requirements chapter of the [CY 2023 D-SNP Policy Guide](#) and the [CY 2023 D-SNP Reporting Requirements Technical Specifications](#).

### Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI) Measure

The table below displays the data that D-SNPs reported to DHCS on an annual basis for the state specific Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI) measure for members age 65 years and older for Contract Year (CY) 2023. The table displays the percent of members age 65 and older who had cognition assessed during the reporting period by plan.
