

This report provides data on the Medicare delivery system including Medicare Advantage (MA) enrollment among beneficiaries dually eligible for Medicare and Medi-Cal, based on data at the California Department of Health Care Services. The definition on the types of MA plans and Original Medicare included in this report are:

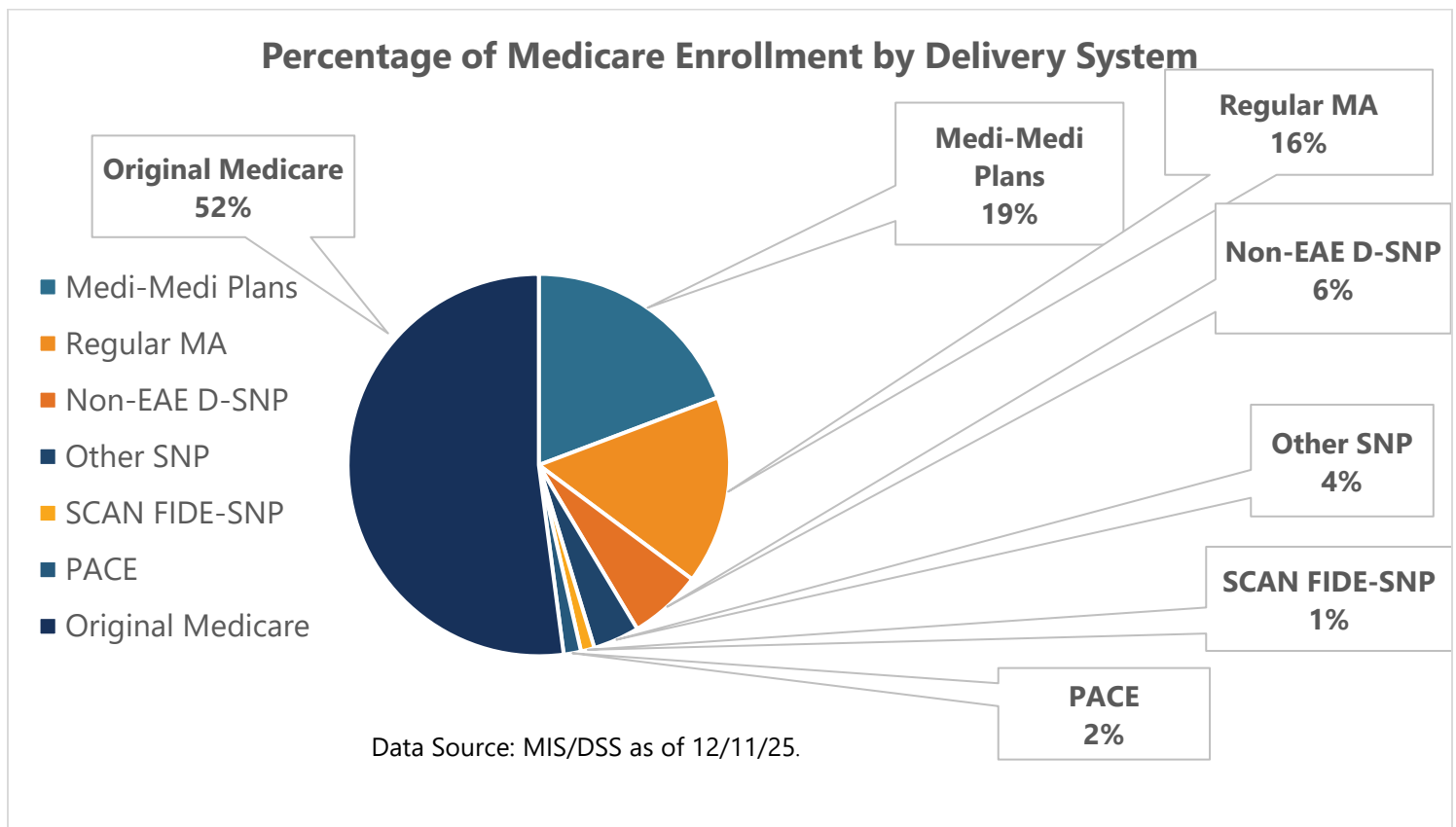
- **Original Medicare:** Original Medicare includes Medicare Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Medicare Part B (Medical Insurance). Original Medicare covers things like inpatient hospital care, doctor's services and tests, and preventive services. A member with Original Medicare can go to any doctor or hospital that takes Medicare.
- **Regular MA Plans:** These plans serve both dual eligible and Medicare only members and are not required to have written agreements with state Medicaid agencies, such as DHCS, for benefit and care coordination for dual eligible beneficiaries.
- **Medicare Medi-Cal Plans (Medi-Medi Plans or MMPs):** Also known as Exclusively Aligned Enrollment (EAE) D-SNPs, these plans are a type of MA plan that meet integrated D-SNP care coordination requirements, with integrated member materials, and have membership limited to dually eligible individuals who are also enrolled in the Medi-Cal managed care plan affiliated with the D-SNP. Medi-Medi Plans are available in 12 counties in 2025: Fresno, Kings, Los Angeles, Madera, Orange, Riverside, Sacramento, San Bernardino, San Diego, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and Tulare.
- **Non-EAE D-SNPs:** D-SNPs are a type of MA plan that provide specialized care and wrap-around services for dual eligible beneficiaries. Non-EAE D-SNPs include two types of plans: 1) Those that have an affiliated Medi-Cal plan but are not yet transitioned to EAE D-SNPs; 2) Plans that do not have an affiliated Medi-Cal plan.
- **Fully Integrated Dual Eligible Special Needs Plan (FIDE-SNP):** California has one FIDE-SNP, SCAN Connections and SCAN Connections at Home, that provide integrated Medicare and Medi-Cal benefits to dually eligible beneficiaries. The SCAN FIDE-SNP only operates in Los Angeles, Riverside, San Bernardino, and San Diego counties.
- **Program of All-Inclusive Care for the Elderly (PACE):** PACE is an integrated care model that provides medical and long-term services and supports

individuals age 55 and older who meet the criteria for needing a nursing facility level of care, most of whom are dually eligible individuals. California has several PACE organizations.

- **Chronic Condition Special Needs Plans (C-SNPs):** C-SNPs are SNPs that restrict enrollment to special needs individuals with specific severe or disabling chronic conditions, defined in 42 CFR 422.2. Approximately two-thirds of Medicare enrollees have multiple chronic conditions requiring coordination of care among primary providers, medical and mental health specialists, inpatient and outpatient facilities, and extensive ancillary services related to diagnostic testing and therapeutic management.
- **Institutional Special Needs Plans (I-SNPs):** I-SNPs are SNPs that restrict enrollment to MA eligible individuals who, for 90 days or longer, have had or are expected to need the level of services provided in a long-term care (LTC) skilled nursing facility (SNF), a LTC nursing facility (NF), a SNF/NF, an intermediate care facility for individuals with intellectual disabilities (ICF/IDD), or an inpatient psychiatric facility.

The figure and tables below reflect only those with Medicare Part A and Part B eligibility, and Medi-Cal eligibility, who are enrolled in some type of MA plan.
